

# BEAUTY THERAPY ADVANCED APPRENTICESHIP LEVEL 3



**DURATION:** 1 year

## SUBJECT OVERVIEW

This apprenticeship will equip you with the skills and knowledge to carry out the most popular treatments required by salons: facial and body electricals, Indian head massage and epilation, as well as self-tanning, health and safety and event planning. The qualification will give you the skills to work nationally and internationally.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

**Grade requirements:** You will need a minimum of four GCSEs at grades A\*-D or 9-3, including English and maths, plus a full Level 2 qualification in Beauty Therapy.

**Other requirements:** You also need to be working at a beauty salon or spa.

## COURSE CONTENT

**During this apprenticeship you will study a range of topics, including:**

- Monitor procedures to safely control work operations
- Implement promotional activities
- Body Massage
- Facial electricals
- Body electricals
- Indian Head Massage
- Self Tanning and Epilation

## ASSESSMENT METHODS

You will be assessed via online exams for theory and client-based assessments for the practical units.
